Concurrent Enrollment for High School Juniors and Seniors

OBU is committed to providing concurrent enrollment opportunities to area high school students. Many outstanding high school students are ready for the challenges of collegiate course work prior to the completion of the senior year. Superior students have often completed most of the basic high school requirements by the beginning of the senior year and have time available for selection of courses of special interest or collegiate-level courses. Be aware that full-time, on-campus, degree-seeking OBU students have first choice of classes, thus **class availability may be limited some semesters for concurrent students.**

All grades received become a part of the student's permanent college record. While attending OBU, the student has the rights and responsibilities designated in the OBU Catalog and the Student Handbook.

Admission Requirements

High school senior and junior students are eligible to enroll in concurrent classes if they meet the following minimum criteria. Some classes may have higher minimum requirements.

Test Score	High School GPA
21 ACT or 1050 SAT I	3.0
20 ACT or 1000 SAT I	3.25

Senior applicants must have a minimum ACT sub-score of 19 (SAT I verbal score of 470 or math score of 460) in the subject area in which they plan to enroll.

Senior applicants are eligible to enroll in freshman level courses totaling six hours each semester. Junior applicants are eligible to enroll in specified courses totaling three hours each semester. OBU classes range from one to three credit hours.

Application Procedures

An application for concurrent enrollment is attached. *Application to the concurrent program must be made for each semester of study.* There is no application fee. Each of the following documents is necessary to enroll in a concurrent class.

- Completed application, signed by high school counselor or principal
- An official high school transcript
- Official ACT or SAT scores (if not shown on high school transcript)

Enrollment Opportunities

- Concurrent students may enroll for the **fall** semester beginning the first week in May.
- Concurrent students may enroll for the **spring** semester beginning the first week in December.
- Concurrent students may enroll for the **summer** semester beginning the first week in May.
