1. **Unveiled at Last** by Bob Sjogren- Read your Bible as one book with one introduction, one story and one conclusion. Discover a unifying theme woven throughout the Scriptures from Genesis to Revelation.

2. **Run With the Vision** by Bob Sjogren and Bill and Amy Stearns- This book outlines the remarkable breakthroughs taking place in our world, identifies the doors opening to the Gospel and shows how churches can become active, mobilizing, missionary-sending congregations without abandoning local concerns.

3. **The Creation of a Student Movement to Evangelize the World** by Timothy Wallstorm- This little book is the exciting story of how students did their work, making history's greatest acceleration in global missions a reality by the massive push of a true student uprising.

4. **Operation World** by Patrick Johnstone- This small prayer encyclopedia is the must-have guide for anyone desiring to pray for the nations in a specific, educated way. It includes pertinent data on every one of the world's countries and is organized into a daily prayer system.

5. **Catch the Vision 2000** by Bill and Amy Stearns- "Something big and challenging is happening in our world; something God wants every Christian to be involved in," say the authors, who put together a remarkable lay-oriented book on how God is reaching the world today with the gospel.

6. **Let the Nations be Glad** by John Piper- This book will help students of mission reflect on the relationship between church and mission and on the role of every Christian in the Great Commission.

7. **Touch the World Through Prayer** by Wesley Duewel- Duewel compellingly explains how every Christian can pray for the missionaries, church leaders and political leaders in countries around the globe where the gospel is being preached today.

8. **The Church is Bigger Than You Think** by Patrick Johnstone- Anchored in the eternal perspective of Biblical truth, this book guides the reader through the historical development of the Christian Mission before launching into a practical discussion of the structures and strategies needed to carry out the mission.

10. **Shadow of the Almighty** by Elisabeth Elliot- Jim Elliot was one of the five missionaries killed while trying to reach the savage Auca Indians of Ecuador. His widow, Elisabeth, powerfully uses Jim's incredibly rich diaries to give the reader intimate insights in to the life and devotion of this godly man.

11. **Bruchko** by Bruce Olson- The compelling true story of a single missionary who leaves for the field at 19 years old! Olson's life of incredible faith and conviction is an inspiration and a challenge.

12. **Disciples of Joy** by Ray Wiseman- This book constructs an authentic and sympathetic account of what it is like to live, learn, be converted, and minister within the context of a Hindu society.

13. **What in the World is God Doing?** by C. Gordon Olson- It features a study from Genesis to Revelation, highlights over a dozen key missions figures, offers a thumbnail sketch of major world religions and gives the current status of Gospel penetration around the world.

14. **Answering Islam: The Crescent in Light of the Cross** by Norman L. Geisler and Abdul Saleeb- Geisler and Saleeb examine the basic doctrines of Islam and then give a Christian response to basic Muslim beliefs, followed by a defense of the Christian perspective.

15. **Friend Raising** by Betty Barnett- Dr. Carl Armerding says this book "Brings together God's plan for Biblical missions support, with principles proven in the field." It is a handy, introductory guide for anyone seeking to fund his or her ministry through support.

16. **Uncle Cam: The story of William Cameron Townsend** by James and Marti Hefley- This is the story of a man who wanted to see the word of God made available in every language. It is the remarkable life account of the founder of Wycliffe Bible Translators.

17. **The World at Your Door** by Tom Phillips and Bob Norsworthy- Learn how to practically and effectively minister to the nearly half a million international students in American universities.

18. **Prepare for Battle** by Neal and Yvonne Pirolo- Making reference to over 700 Scripture passages that point to victory in battle, the author drives home the importance of understanding the basics of spiritual warfare.
