Credit By Examination



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT CREDIT BY EXAMINATION:

1. Students may earn up to 32 semester hours of credit by examination.
2. These credits may be earned through College Board AP, CLEP Subject Examinations, or OBU Advanced Standing or Performance Examinations. No credit is granted for CLEP General Examinations.
3. CLEP is administered monthly on campus and Advanced Standing or Performance Examinations by appointment; AP credit comes through the student's high school (only a limited number of high schools participate).

4. Students must register for OBU Advanced Standing or Performance Examinations in the Academic Center, Thurmond Hall 201, prior to the exam and must sit for the exam at the appointed time. Students must register for the CLEP exam in the University Testing Office in Geiger Center 101 at least three weeks prior to the exam and must sit for the exam at the appointed time. Call extension 2420 for CLEP registration deadlines and exam dates.

Students wanting to test out of foreign language through the CLEP exam must first obtain a form from the OBU modern language department. This form must be turned in to the University Testing Office when registering for the exam.

5. Credit is granted at the equivalent of “C” level as determined by the instructor for OBU Advanced Standing or Performance Examinations. Required scores for AP, CLEP and PEP are listed on the tables in this brochure.

6. If the student scores at the required level, credit is recorded on the OBU Permanent Record (transcript) specified as being by examination and with a grade of “S” for Satisfactory. If the student fails to score at the required level, no entry is made on the Permanent Record. The student receives written notice of the results of his examination from the Registrar as soon as the scores are received from ACT, Educational Testing Service or the local instructor.

7. Sample CLEP questions are available in the Test Center Office, Geiger Center 101.

8. CLEP exams may be repeated only after six months. If retaken before six months have passed, scores will be cancelled and fee forfeited.

9. Failure to take exams at the time for which registered may result in forfeiture of fees and, in some cases, fines to be paid to the testing company.

NOTE: Allow TWO WEEKS OR MORE for receipt of official transcript of CLEP scores. Students taking CLEP exams online in the OBU Testing Center will receive a student score report immediately.
