Alumni Achievement Award Nomination Form

Deadline for nominations is April 15, 2009.

Considered the highest honor bestowed by the OBU Alumni Association, Achievement Awards are presented each year during the Homecoming Harvest Dinner.

- A nominee must be a former student, not necessarily a graduate, who has “demonstrated outstanding achievement in his or her profession, business, vocation, or life service.” Award criteria state that the achievement must be “of such nature as to justify pride on the part of the OBU community for its part in the contribution.”
- Awards are approved by the alumni board of directors upon recommendation by the board’s honors and awards committee.
- Up to three achievement awards are presented annually at Homecoming. Since 1955, a total of 141 Alumni Achievement Awards have been presented to outstanding OBU alumni. A directory of Alumni Achievement Award recipients is available in the alumni section of OBU’s website (www.okbu.edu).
- This form should be accompanied by a letter of nomination, detailed biographical information on the nominee, and other supporting material. Documentation of the nominee’s contributions should be in the form of a resumé, supported by extensive letters of recommendation. (Well-documented nominations are greatly appreciated by the honors and awards committee.)
