Learn basic shooting fundamentals from OBU coaches and players. Campers will work on drills to develop:

- footwork
- catching the ball and court vision
- balance & agility work
- passing to shooters
- triple threat (pass, shoot, dribble)
- following through
- how to get open
- ball release

Each day we will drill for 30 minutes on ball handling and these other offensive fundamentals:

- triple threat stance
- passing
- rebounding
- court awareness
- shooting
- body control
- footwork

Coach John McCullough

Coach John McCullough has led OBU to the NAIA Championship Tournament in each of his eight years as Lady Bison head coach. The Lady Bison's record is 182-86 for the past eight seasons.

McCullough was an All-American at the University of Oklahoma, and was named Big 8 Conference MVP in 1979. He went on to play for the Phoenix Suns in the NBA and in France.
