

WHERE DO OBU GRADUATES GO?


OVERVIEW

Graduates from the 2022-23 academic year were given a post-graduation survey which addressed plans for graduate school enrollment and employment upon graduation.

DESTINATION OUTCOME

The Office of Career Development acquired career outcomes for 304 (81% knowledge rate) of the students. Respondents indicated that 77% are employed; 1% are not seeking employment; 11% are attending graduate program; 9% are employed and attending a graduate program; and a total of 2% is seeking employment.

98% of the Class of 2023 are employed, enrolled in graduate school, or not seeking employment.



- * Academic year refers to all undergraduates completing degree requirements in December and May.
- * Knowledge rate refers to the percentage of graduates for whom knowledge of their first-destination career outcomes has been obtained. This includes survey data provided by students, LinkedIn profile information and knowledge shared from academic departments.
