WHERE DO OBU GRADUATES GO?

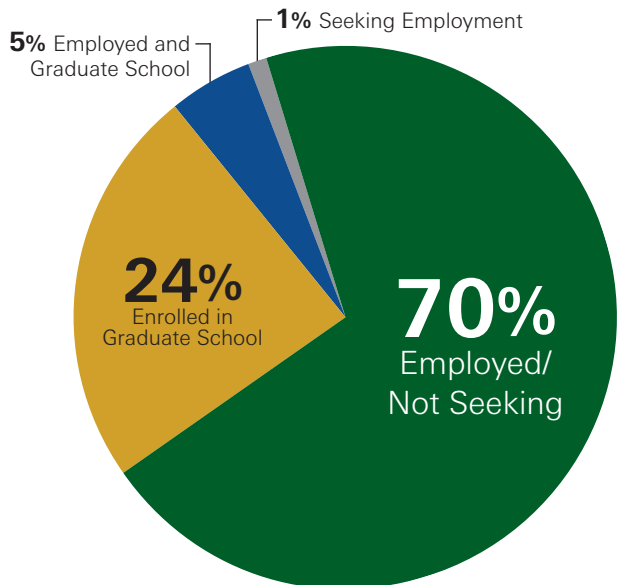
OVERVIEW

Graduates from the 2021-22 academic year were given a post-graduation survey which addressed plans for graduate school enrollment and employment upon graduation.

DESTINATION OUTCOME

The Office of Career Development acquired career outcomes for 289 (81% knowledge rate) of the students. Respondents indicated that 70% had accepted employment or were not seeking, 24% were seeking further education, 5% are employed and attending a graduate program, and a total of 1% was seeking employment.

99% of the Class of 2022 are employed, enrolled in graduate school, or not seeking employment.



* Academic year refers to all undergraduates completing degree requirements in December and May.

* Knowledge rate refers to the percentage of graduates for whom knowledge of their first-destination career outcomes has been obtained. This includes survey data provided by students, LinkedIn profile information and knowledge shared from academic departments.
