WHERE DO OBU GRADUATES GO?

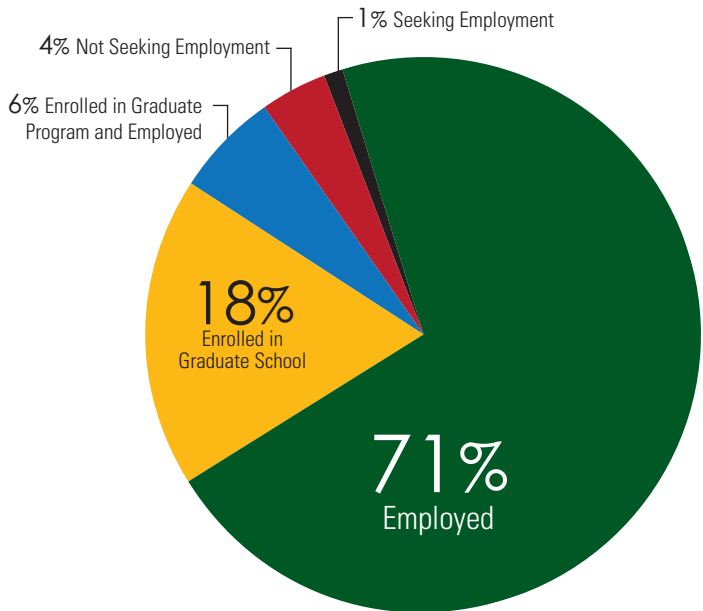
OVERVIEW

Graduates from the 2018-2019 academic year were given a post-graduation survey which addressed plans for graduate school enrollment and employment upon graduation.

DESTINATION OUTCOME

The Office of Career Development acquired career outcomes for 317 (87% knowledge rate) of the students. Respondents indicated that 71% had accepted employment, 18% were seeking further education, 6% were employed and seeking further education, 4% were working part-time or taking time off, and 1% were seeking employment.

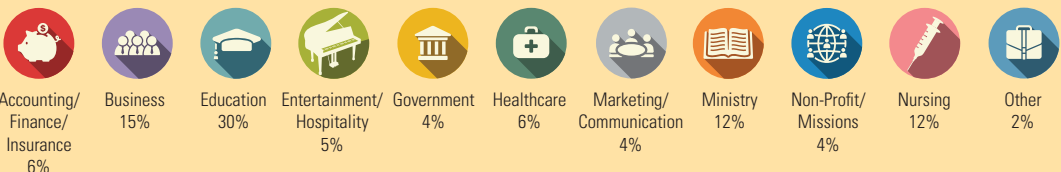
99% of the Class of 2019 are employed, enrolled in graduate school, both, or not seeking employment.



* Academic year refers to all graduates, completing degree requirements in December, May and July.

* Knowledge rate refers to the percentage of graduates for whom knowledge of their first-destination career outcomes has been obtained. This includes survey data provided by students, LinkedIn profile information and knowledge shared from academic departments.
