In addition to the OBU graduation requirements outlined in the Academic Catalog, a nursing student cannot receive a final transcript unless they have achieved a Level II on all Assessment Technology Institute (ATI) Mastery Exams required by the College of Nursing. If a Level II is not achieved on any one exam, after a second attempt, the student is required to provide proof of an NCLEX review course. Upon validation of achievement of Level II on all ATI Mastery Exams or certificate of completion of NCLEX review course, the final transcript will be released.

No D's will be accepted in the area of concentration and the supportive courses or in courses comprising Nursing majors and minors.
