- ability to teach others how to safely use common tools and equipment
- set up and tear down lab experiments for engineering and science classes

- maintain engineering and science stockrooms

- Be able to use common woodworking and metalworking tools and equipment
- Be able to lift mild weights such as plywood and metal bars.
