Purpose

Under limited supervision, performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled work in the maintenance of university facilities in the evenings from 2:00 pm till 11:00 pm.

Essential Functions

• Troubleshoots minor maintenance problems involving electrical, structural, plumbing,

and equipment repair or replacement.

• Perform electrical maintenance tasks such as replacing lamps/bulbs, reset

breakers, and reset ground fault receptacles.

- Perform plumbing maintenance tasks such as unstop toilets or urinals, sinks, etc.
- Perform preventive maintenance tasks on HVAC equipment.
- Perform maintenance to restore function to door hardware.
- Make walk-thru inspections of all buildings, and perform the above tasks as needed.

• May be required to work overtime and after-hours including nights and weekends for campus special events or when emergencies arise. Indoor/outdoor work as required.

Ability to document work orders and prioritize the after-hour service calls.

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Other Duties

• Any additional duties assigned by the Facilities Services Supervisor-Trades or the Manager of Facilities Services.

Qualifications

Required

- Working knowledge and skills in electrical and plumbing trades required.
- Working knowledge of other trades related to building maintenance and repair.
- Ability to effectively communicate with co-workers, students, staff, and faculty.
- High school diploma or GED
- One to two years practical maintenance experience in multiple trades.
- Ability to safely use hand tools, power tools and operate relevant equipment.
- Ability to safely use personal lifting machinery.
- Ability to sit, stand, walk, climb, bend, kneel, and grasp. Safely lift eighty pounds.
- Ability to work extended periods of time up to eighty feet elevated in lifting equipment.
- Ability to work in attics, under houses, basements.
- Must possess and maintain a valid Oklahoma Driver's license.
- Employment is contingent upon results of a drug and background screening.
- This person may be required to work overtime, or adjust their schedule as needed when it is deemed necessary by their supervisor.

Preferred

- Trade school, technical training, apprenticeship.
- Three to five years practical maintenance experience in multiple trades.

Special Requirements

- Active membership in a local, Evangelical Christian church *
