*** For every 6 hours of language credit at the undergraduate level (with a B or better) we offer you the opportunity to proceed into the next logical level. So a student with 6 hours of Greek or Hebrew at the undergraduate level may skip the introductory class at NOBTS and enroll in the intermediate class; a student with 12 hours may skip both the introductory and intermediate classes and proceed directly to an advanced exegesis or advanced grammar class. Upon successful completion of the intermediate or advanced class (with a B or better), the student will verify his/her grade with the Accelerated MDiv office to be given credit for those classes he/she skipped and will pay 1/3 tuition for those skipped classes.*
